LIBRARY



Art & Craft Sessions: Creative workshops encourage students to express themselves through painting, sculpture, and other artistic endeavors.



ADMISSION PROCESS

Roots Country School, Panchkula welcomes young learners from Nursery to Class X to a joyful and secure learning environment that nurtures confidence, curiosity, and character. We believe every child is unique, and our admission process is designed to identify each student's strengths through a general basic evaluation that helps us understand their readiness and learning needs. Our goal is to ensure that every child feels valued, supported, and excited to begin their educational journey with us.

ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

- **Eligibility Criteria** : For admission to Nursery, the child must be 3 years or above as of the beginning of the academic session And for admission to class 1, the child must have attained the age of 6 years.
- Admission is open to all boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status who are mentally and physically having attained the age of 3 years.
- Applications forms for registration/admission to all classes are available at the school office.
- Students other than the CBSE board must get Migration Certificate.
- The Principal reserves the right of granting or refusing admission to anyone who seek admission to the school.

FEE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- At the time of admission, parents must deposit admission charges, annual charges, security money, and the registration fee. Annual charges can be paid yearly or half- yearly as per parent's preference.
- Fees may be deposited either monthly or quarterly. Full advance payment grants a 3% concession on the total amount.
- Late fee charges for the monthly plan are Rs.100/day, while for the quarterly plan it is Rs.200/day.
- Late fees apply from the 10th of every month for monthly dues, and for quarterly dues on 10th April, 10th July, 10th October, and 10th January.
- If dues are not paid by the end of the month, the student will not be allowed to attend classes and assessments until dues are cleared.
- No reminders for dues will be sent. Parents are expected to comply with the regulations to avoid disputes.
- If fees are not paid, management reserves the right to ask for the child's withdrawal from school.
- School fees are non-refundable, except for the security deposit.
- If withdrawing a child from school, one month's advance notice must be given in writing or via email.
- No School Leaving Certificate (SLC) will be issued if dues for the term or quarter have not been fully paid. There are no fee refunds in mid-session, and if the student enters a quarter, full charges for that quarter apply.
- Bus fare is additional, based on the route, and is charged for 11 months on a quarterly basis, as per management's decision.



HOUSE SYSTEM


